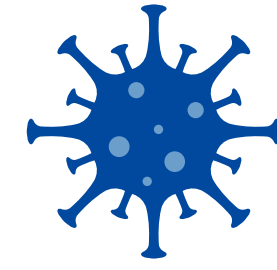




CORONA INFORMATION:



COVID-19 is a new respiratory disease, caused by a coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2). The disease was declared a pandemic and is transmitted from person to person, mainly through respiratory droplets.

Within 14 days after an infection, symptoms that indicate COVID-19 may occur.

In particular, these are fever, newly occurring cough, loss of smell or taste, shortness of breath



PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

1. Quarantine:

In case you enter Germany from abroad and have been in a risk area* for 14 days prior to entry, generally, a 14-day quarantine is mandatory.

Exceptions are possible in the case of a negative PCR test for SARS-CoV-2 for a maximum of 48 hours before entry or after entry.

2. Rules for reducing contact and hygiene:



DISTANCE:

A minimum distance of 1.5 m should be maintained in public wherever possible.



HYGIENE:

When coughing and sneezing, keep your distance and turn away from others. Hold the crook of your arm in front of your mouth and nose or use a handkerchief that you should dispose of immediately.

Wash your hands regularly with soap and water and avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.



FACE MASK:

A face mask must be worn in certain public areas.

FOR TRAVELERS:



For travel within Germany the rules of the federal states apply**. The Federal Foreign Office is currently advising against unnecessary tourist travel to all countries outside the EU, the Schengen area and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
